Twenty years ago, exactly on this special Day, the protracted political and military struggle of the heroic people of Ethiopia led by the Ethiopian Peoples' Revolutionary Democratic Front (EPRDF) dismantled one of the most cruel tyrant regimes of our era, a regime that unleashed a senseless war against the Ethiopian people and committed war crimes, crime against humanity and genocide.

The victory on this special Day has brought in an end to tyrannies perpetrated by successive predatory regimes.

The New Ethiopia is constituted on the basis of equality, mutual respect, common desire and interest of all nations, nationalities and peoples of Ethiopia as well as of religions and faiths in the country.

The hard won victory of the Ethiopian People on this illustrious Day has brought about a fundamental transformation in the political-economy of the country.

Today, Ethiopia is in a dynamic process of transformation.

The building of institutions of democracy, good governance and the rule of law is further deepening and gaining strength.

Ethiopia's economy is among the top 10 fastest growing economies in the world. Its GDP has been growing at an average growth rate of 11.5% annually for the last seven consecutive years. By sustaining this growth rate as a baseline, Ethiopia's Gross National Income, GNI currently which is the fifth largest economy in Sub-Sahara Africa is expected to double in the coming five years. Ethiopia is also among countries that are performing well and hopeful to achieving the MDGs by 2015.

In this regard, I wish to pay tribute to our brothers and sisters in Africa and to our friends and partners outside the continent for their solidarity and support. A friend in need is a friend in deed. Without your partnership our pace of transformation would have been more challenging and difficult.

Our friendship of cooperation and partnership with China in the development of infrastructure, transfer of technology and capacity building is second to none. I wish to express the satisfaction of my Government to our Chinese friends and look forward to seeing more robust and enhanced cooperation and friendship between our two countries in the months and years to come.
